On March 21, 2024, we hosted An Evening of Gratitude for our donors and supporters at the CrossRoads church foyer.

The evening began with Board Chair, Dean Edwards, giving a warm welcome and opening with prayer. Executive Director, Ruby Stones, shared reflections from 2023 along with the following stats of clients we served:

- 899 unique clients
- 472 were new clients
- 86 children/youth under 18
- 287 unique male clients
- 612 unique female clients

Shari Moore, one of our Registered Psychologists, shared a client's journey that spans over 10 years of receiving counselling through Shalom. The client shared, "I can honestly say I wouldn't be here if it wasn't for my counsellor. She helped me when I didn't want to be helped, didn't feel

I deserved to be helped. Shalom's sliding scale helped me because when my benefits ran out, and I was a student. I wouldn't have been able to afford therapy otherwise."

It is because of stories like this that we are thankful for vour support! We strive to give the best counselling service to our community and have a vision for 2024. Board member, Dwayne Holland, shared this (more on this in page 2). Board member Bill Spangler closed the evening with prayer.
